This is in response to your September 22, 2008, electronic Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for “[c]opies of any communication between the office of Congressman Michael McCaul (R-TX) and the Department of Defense pertaining to the production of the Family of Medium Tactical Vehicles (FMTV) in Sealy, Texas from 2005 to the present.” We received your request on that same date, and subsequently received your amended request on September 28, 2009, which changed the period of time covered by your request from January 1, 2005, to January 1, 2007.

The Executive Serviced Directorate, a component of the Office of the Secretary of Defense, was tasked to search for the records described in your request. Although a thorough search was conducted, no responsive records were found.

The Office of the Secretary of Defense incurred assessable fees totaling \$110 in the processing of your request. These fees represent two and one-half hours of search time at the professional rate of \$44 per hour. Accordingly, please remit a check or money order made payable to the U.S. Treasury in the amount of \$110, within 30 days of the date of this letter, to the Office of Freedom of Information, 1155 Defense Pentagon, Washington, DC 20301-1155, and cite FOIA case number 09-F-1756.

If you consider this no record response to be a denial of your request, you may appeal to the appellate authority, the Director of Administration and Management, Office of the Secretary of Defense, by writing directly to the Defense Freedom of Information Policy Office, Attn: Mr. James Hogan, 1155 Defense Pentagon, Washington, DC 20301-1155. Your appeal should be postmarked within 60 days of the date of this letter, should cite FOIA request number 09-F-1756, and should be clearly marked “Freedom of Information Act Appeal.”
